SUPPLEMENTAL BCBSM REPORTING

We wanted to update our members on NPO's progress with sending supplemental EMR data to BCBSM (Blue Cross/Blue Shield). Supplemental data is clinical data extracted from a registry or EMR (in our case from NPO's HEDIS registry) and sent to a payer to complement claims data in closing care gaps. Claims data remains the preferred and primary means to close gaps in care. Currently, we are sending a monthly file to BCBSM for practices that are connected to the registry for a small set of values; however, we are working with our vendor (eClinicalWorks) and BCBSM to send more data in order to alleviate some of the work practices and NPO undertake to update

Health e-Blue; i.e., over time, we can expect that less data will need to be manually entered on an annual basis.

We will continue you to update on our progress.

COMMUNITY REGISTRY UPDATE

We are currently involved in implementing numerous enhancements to both the registry's back-end infrastructure (to accommodate additional practices) and to provide users with additional features. While we currently aim to refresh the registry either weekly or biweekly, we will, until the end of May or early June, have to limit refreshes to once per month (beginning the 15th of every month). This temporary limitation is to allow both eClinicalWorks and NPO to test new features and to complete infrastructure upgrades.


- 1. Are you able to say "I don't know"
