	Rick spoke of the ways patients can divert their meds and how the DEA will investigate if an issue comes up.			
	Proper documentation in the patient record, a plan of care, CSA's and UDS are all important pieces of the compliance rules for prescribers.			
	We also briefly discussed medical marijuana and the implications in the practices. Offices should have a policy for documenting medical marijuana cards and should always request a letter/documentation from the provider who prescribed the card. Cards must be renewed yearly and a current one should be on file. If used properly, medical marijuana should go hand-in-hand with a reduction of opioid pain medications.
