Presentation	Presenter today was Judi Smuck, Referral Specialist for Integrity Home Health & Skilled Care.			
	Judi gave a very informative presentation about the difference between Home Health and Skilled Care and what Integrity can offer. Judi spoke of the background of the company and how the entire staff meets once a week to discuss each patient to ensure they are getting the best possible care.			
	Judi explained that the number one requirement for a patient to be considered for home care is the patient needs to be homebound.			
	Integrity's goal is to keep patients in their home, promote care by PCP, avoid hospitalizations & institutional living and avoid 30 day readmissions.			
	Judi explained the homebound status & qualifications. She informed us that there is no limit on visits as long as the patient still needs additional care. There is no deductible.			
	Judi stated there are certain criteria to follow in order to qualify for an assessment for home care. During that assessment the assessor can observe if other help is needed for the patient, i.e., MSW, OT or PT. Once assessment has been made a "485" form will be filled out with what is recommended and sent to the PCP to sign.			
	Judi reviewed the referral process and what was needed at the providers end. An order signed by the provider, documentation of face to face			

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	encounter, demographics, med list and patient history would need to be faxed to 231.946.3611
