

Medical Terminology Made Easier for Patients Thanks to a Web-Based Tool


A patient's misunderstanding of health information is often



a result of the patient having low health literacy skills. Many times as health professionals we find ourselves using technical terms which are familiar to us, without recognizing these technical terms are confusing and unfamiliar for patients. The University of Michigan, along with the

University of Illinois at Chicago created a Plain Language Medical Dictionary Google application utilizing a grant from the National Library of Medicine. The web-based tool was built using the Center for Disease Control's *Plain Language Thesaurus for Health Communications*. Users are able to browse through a list of high-level medical terms and find the plain language equivalent terms. The web-based tool can be found by
