Reminders and Updates

NPO and Munson are co-hosting a no-charge Tools for Transformation session on Wednesday 2/12/14 from 6-8PM at the Traverse City Country Club. The topic is Leading Your Practice Through the Perfect Work Day and includes a LEAN simulation. Attending physicians receive 2.0 hours of CME.

BCBSM, due to the high number of capabilities reported by NPO for specialists, and the number of NPO specialists receiving uplifts, has asked to conduct site visits of some specialists to learn about capabilities. These site visits will be held during the first two weeks of February with 8 BCBSM staff.

Dr. Diane Parsons, Medical Director for Munson Hospice and Palliative, is available to discuss with practice's physicians palliative care and hospice, and how the two differ. She can also discuss changes that have taken place in the program so that more patients can receive the appropriate care.

Dr. Hill, from Brookside, with some specialist input is working on guidelines for referrals, including electronic referrals. There is a physician meeting end of February regarding this.

Kelly Saxton is working part-time with NPO on PCMH and quality. Laura Salvatore is also a new add to NPO; she assists with PCMH, membership list, specialist uplifts – the list goes on!

Revised BCBSM PCMH-N Guidelines

Kris Elliott, from NPO, reviewed the Revised BCBSM PCMH-N Guidelines using the BCBSM Powerpoint (included in email).

- BCBSM is adding more clarification on many measures and "raising the bar" on a few.
- Some new capabilities are added; many for the MiPct practices.
- Most changes do not take place until 7/1/14. These dates are noted in the Powerpoint.
- The redlined version of the Guidelines is available on the NPO website.
- There were some questions generated which NPO is taking back to BCBSM. Answers, when received, will be distributed.
