- AAMA American Association of Medical Assistants
- AMT American Medical Technologist
- NCCT National Center for Competency Testing
- NAHP National Association for Health Professionals

### AAMA aama-ntl.org

- Certified Medical Assistant CMA
- Must be a graduate of accredited program
- 200 multiple choice questions in 40 minute segments
- \$125 if member of AAMA or graduating student,
  \$250 if past graduate/nonmember



- 60 Recertification points in 60 months or reexamination
- 10 points Administrative, 10 points Clinical, 10 points General and additional 30 points any combination of these
- At least 30 points must be AAMA approved CEU's

- Registered Medical Assistant RMA
- Graduated from program or ...
- Work experience as an MA 5 of the last 7 years
- Application fee \$95

- 4-6 weeks to process the application
- Continuing Education (CE) required every three years
- Reference materials and practice test available

- National Certified Medical Assistant NCMA
- Graduated from a program or...
- 2 years as an MA in the past 10 years
- Testing fee \$135
