ON-SITE SUPPORT GROUPS FOR ALL AGES:

Michael's Place mission is to provide a safe environment to enable healthy healing after the death of a loved one. Children, teens, and adults need to feel protected as they share their story. All support groups are team-facilitated by trained volunteer facilitators who provide the necessary guidance along the peer-to-peer support group journey. Children meet in age-appropriate groups and participate in discussions, art projects, games, and activities. Teens have a support group customized to meet their needs. With the help of mentors, Robin's Nest provides best day activities and educational opportunities designed to help grieving children and their families feel normal, bring joy to their lives, and create new memories.

IN-SCHOOL SUPPORT GROUPS & SCHOOL GRIEF CRISIS SUPPORT

In-school support groups are offered to elementary, middle, and high school students grieving the death of a loved one. Professional guidance is provided to schools to develop grief crisis plans, assist with aftercare following the death of a school community member, and for ongoing grief education and training.

BUSINESS AND COMMUNITY:

Professional guidance is provided to businesses and community organizations to develop grief crisis plans and provide grief education and training to meet the unique needs of the requesting organization.

CREATE-A-KEEPSAKE:
