| Measure Name | Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months of Life |
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| Relevance | NPO Population Clinical Quality Dashboard [NQF 1392: Pediatric Measure] |
| Measure Definition | <i>The percentage of patients who turn 15 months old during the Measurement Period <u>AND</u> who had at least six well-child visits with a PCP in their first 15 months of life</i> |
| Measurement Period | The Measurement Period is defined as the current calendar year (January 1 - December 31) |
| Denominator | The Denominator consists of patients who turn 15 months old during the Measurement Period |
| Numerator | <p>The Numerator consists of patients, from the Denominator, who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I. Have received 6 or more well-child visits II. On different dates of service III. With a PCP* IV. During their first 15 months of life <p>*Note: The well-child visit must occur with a PCP, but the PCP does not have to be the practioner the patient is attributed to</p> |

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| <p style="text-align: center;">Measure Documentation <i>(continued)</i></p> | <p style="text-align: center;"><u>To Satisfy This Measure</u> <i>(Numerator Documentation)</i></p> <p>I. See the patient for at least six applicable well-care visits before the end of the Measurement Period</p> <p>A. The following CPT/HCPCS codes identify applicable pediatric well-care visits for this age range: 99381 - 99382 and 99391 - 99392</p> <p>B. The following ICD-10 diagnosis codes identify a pediatric well-care visit for this age range:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Z00.121, Z00.129, Z00.5, Z00.70, Z00.71 and Z00.8 2. Z02.6, Z02.82 and Z02.89 <p>II. Document the well-care visits in one of the following ways:</p> <p>A. Record the appropriate CPT code for the well-care visit in the Billing section of the associated Progress Note <i>(Progress Notes → Billing)</i></p> <p>B. <u>OR</u>, Record the appropriate ICD-10 code in the Problem List of the patient's chart in eCW</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Add a diagnosis to the patient's Problem List by recording it as an assessment on a Progress Note <i>(Progress Note (or Virtual Visit) → Assessments → Problem List → Add)</i> 2. <u>OR</u>, Add a diagnosis to the Problem List from the Right-Hand Chart Panel <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. From the Right-Hand Chart Panel, click the "Overview" tab <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Click the orange button (with three dots) in the Progress Note band 2) Click "Add" b. Helpful Tip: When adding a new diagnosis to the Problem List, enter the onset date (if known) in the associated "Onset Date" field <p style="text-align: right;"><i>(continued)</i></p> |
