Relevance	NPO Population Clinical Quality Dashboard [NQF 1516:Pediatric Measure]
Measure Definition	<i>The percentage of patients, 3-6 years of age, who had one or more well-child visits with the PCP during the Measurement Period</i>
Measurement Period	The Measurement Period is defined as the current calendar year (January 1 - December 31)
Denominator	The Denominator consists of patients who are 3-6 years of age as of December 31 of the Measurement Period
Numerator	<p>The Numerator consists of patients, from the Denominator, who had at least one well-child visit with a PCP during the Measurement Period</p> <p><u>Numerator Note:</u> The well-child visit must occur with a PCP, but the PCP does not have to be the practioner the patient is attributed to</p>
Exclusions and/or Exceptions	None

Helpful Tip: When adding a new diagnosis to the Problem List, enter the onset date (if known) in the associated "Onset Date" field
