

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LOW VISION PROGRAM

What is Low Vision?

Low vision is a visual impairment severe enough to interfere with performance of daily activities, yet allowing some usable vision. There are many different conditions that cause low vision, including:

- Macular Degeneration
- Diabetic Retinopathy
- Prescription eyewear
- Cataracts
- Glaucoma

Low Vision Rehabilitation

The rehabilitation of a visually impaired individual may involve a variety of treatment modalities including:

- Occupational Therapy
- Prescription eyewear
- Optical Adaptive Devices
- Electronic Aids
- Adaptive Computer software
- Glare control
- Modification of the patient's environment
- Counseling and Education of the patient/family
- Skills training
- Medication administration facilitation
- Independent Living aids
- Home Safety Inspection and modification
- Psycho-social changes
- Orientation & Mobility Training



Medical professionals: Ask us how we can help your patients or residents
