OPIOID ALERT

On December 27, 2017, The Lieutenant Governor signed into law several new requirements aimed at combating the opioid epidemic.

DON'T THROW THAT MONEY AWAY!

Please don't disregard NPO mailings - there may have been a check in that envelope! NPO doesn't want to overwhelm practices with mail so NPO is very deliberate with its mailings, only sending those items that members/practices should be aware of. NPO checks are one of the items distributed via the mail.

When NPO was reconciling uncashed checks over 90 days old, NPO learned that a few NPO members had not cashed approximately \$30,000 in NPO checks sent via the mail. To ensure members receive these funds, NPO will be calling those practices with uncashed checks over 90 days old to verify the check wasn't received and will reissue checks as needed.

Reissuing checks is an expense for NPO, but NPO wants to ensure members/practices receive the funds they have earned. Please help NPO avoid this in the future by processing all NPO mailings to ensure members/practices receive earned funds promptly. Thank you,

MEDICAL CERTIFICATION FORM

A Medical Certification Form offers utility customers suffering from medical conditions protection from shutoffs.

The Medical Certification Form was recently approved by the Michigan Public Service Commission as part of its update of utility billing rules that make it harder for gas or electric service to be shut off due to nonpayment of bills. A physician or public health care official must complete the form to verify a patient's medical condition justifies restoring service or putting a hold on disconnection.
