

# PROMOTING INTEROPERABILITY

- ▶ Emphasizes patient engagement and the electronic exchange of health information using Certified Electronic Health Record Technology (CEHRT)
- ▶ Requires the use of 2015 CEHRT
- ▶ You only need to report for 90 consecutive days
- ▶ Must report the required measures under each Objectives or claim the exclusions if applicable
