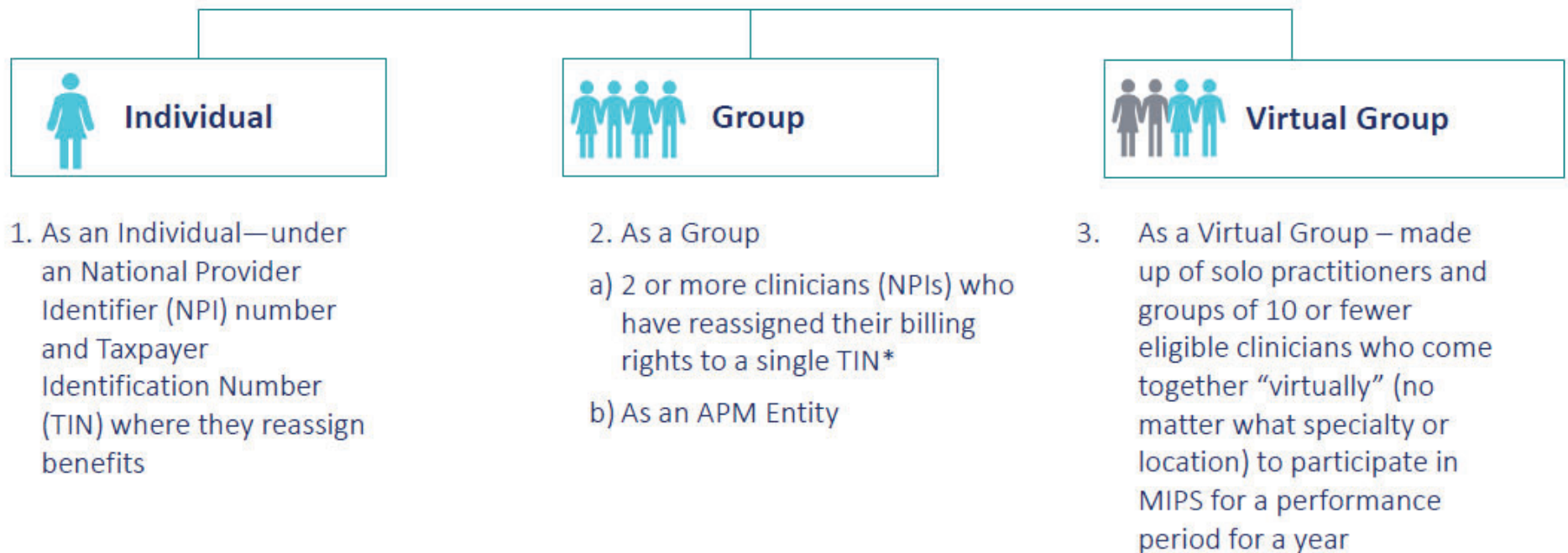


MIPS Reporting Options

▲ What are my reporting options if I am required to participate in MIPS?



MIPS Group Reporting

How does the LVT* apply to Groups?

- ▲ CMS will simultaneously conduct a similar look during each determination period to see if your group contains at least one MIPS eligible clinician type and **collectively** exceeds the low-volume threshold (same criteria)
- ▲ If your group has at least one MIPS eligible clinician and exceeds all three criteria, your group is eligible to participate in MIPS
 - Please note that participating as a group is optional
 - If you are excluded from MIPS as an individual but eligible to participate as a part of a group, you are **not** required to do so (unless TIN opts to report as a group)
- ▲ If your group does not exceed all three criteria, your group is excluded from MIPS and does not need to submit any performance data

MIPS Reporting Options

▲ What happens if a clinician or group is excluded...but still wants to participate in MIPS in 2019?

➤ There are two options:

1. Voluntarily Participate

- Submit MIPS data to CMS and receive performance feedback
- You will not receive a MIPS payment adjustment regardless of performance
- Data will still be publically available on the [Medicare Physician Compare](#) website

2. Opt-In (new for 2019)

- If you are a MIPS eligible clinician type and meet or exceed at least (1) of the (3) low-volume threshold criteria, you may opt-in to MIPS participation
- If you opt-in, you'll be subject to MIPS program rules and subsequent MIPS payment adjustments (+/-/=)
- Once made, this annual decision is irrevocable for that single program year only
- Details on how to Opt-In are still forthcoming from CMS
