Who Qualifies? Low-to-moderate income families and individuals, seniors, persons with disabilities and those with English as a second language.

Who Prepares the Returns? Trained volunteers prepare and electronically file both federal and state returns free of charge.

What should I bring to the appointment? Bring your Social Security, pension and interest statements, wages and earnings statements (2019 Form W-2) from all employers, your 2018 tax return and other relevant
