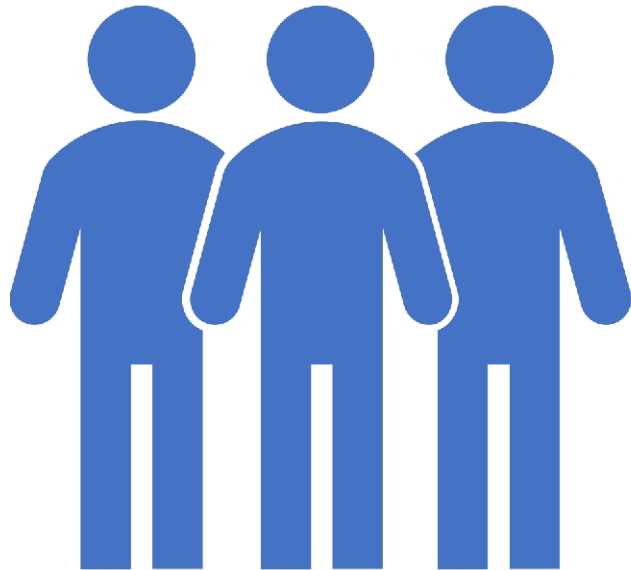

The National Addiction Epidemic



- More than **750,000** people have died since 1999 from a drug overdose
- Overdose deaths involving opioids, including prescription opioids, heroin, and synthetic opioids (like fentanyl), have increased almost **6x** since 1999
- **185** Americans die each day from opioid overdoses and the number is growing. In fact, it has grown nearly 43% since 2016.
- Cost of **\$78.5 billion** annually for pain management, healthcare costs, work loss, legal system - an increase of 39% since 2016.
- **21 million** Americans have a drug or alcohol related addiction
- Of the drug overdose deaths in 2018, **87.4% were unintentional**
- Since Covid, National EMS responses for opioid overdose **increased by 33%** from April to May of this year

The Addiction Epidemic in Michigan

- Michigan's death rate from opioids has **increased 27%** this year & the death rate from opioids is **up 43%**
- Michigan ranks **12th** in per capita prescribing rates of opioids.
- In 2018, Michigan providers wrote 62.7 opioid prescriptions for every 100 persons compared to the average U.S. rate of 51.4 prescriptions.



Predator & Prey

In 2018, Alex Grizzel, a local young man, lost his life to an overdose. His family wanted to do something about educating the community. Through their efforts and outreach, Predator & Prey was born. East Middle School Students and teach Jody Mackey created an 18 minute documentary about the local impact of the opioid crisis.

Addiction Treatment Services wrote an accompanying discussion guide for the film that is available to anyone in the community and beyond.
