NOVELLO INFUSION

Migraine Treatment

Novello Infusion is pleased to offer two types of treatments for Migraines:

- VYEPTI (eptinezumab-jjmr) is indicated for the preventative treatment of both episodic and chronic migraines in adults. It is designed for fast, powerful, and sustained relief. Vyepti is given as intravenously as a single 30-minute infusion every 3 months and there is no required loading dose. Patients often experience a decrease in migraine days per month after the very first treatment.
- HYDRATION is offered during business hours as an alternative to going to the Emergency Department for relief of migraines. Although Novello will not offer narcotic treatment, hydration with ordered additives along with antiemetic medications are often very effective in relieving the patient's symptoms.

Iron Infusions

Novello Infusion offers iron therapy including Injectafer, Feraheme, and Venofer. The Iron Order Template is available on the Novello Infusion web site (https://www.novelloinfusion.org/physician-resources/order-templates). The template is designed to simplify the referral process for the provider and ensure all supporting documentation required by the insurance company is provided to our office.

CMS Expands Coverage of Lung Cancer Screening with Low Dose Computed Tomography

Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has expanded coverage for lung cancer screening with low dose computed tomography (LDCT) to improve health outcomes for people with lung cancer. Lung cancer is one of the most common cancers and the leading cause of cancer-related death in both men and women in the United States. This screening is aimed at early detection of non-small cell lung cancer.

CMS has expanded eligibility for people with Medicare to get lung cancer screening with LCDT by lowering the starting age for screening from 55 to 50 years and reducing the tobacco smoking history from at least 30 packs per year to at least 20 packs per year. The only recommended screening test for lung cancer is LDCT, a unique computed tomography (CT) scan technique that combines special x-ray equipment with sophisticated computers to produce multiple, cross-sectional images of the inside of the body.
