• [Practice Name] Days at Home (2023-11)

This report is specific to the ACO REACH (Medicare FFS) population and lists the number of days spent at home, in the last six months of life, for ACO REACH patients whose date of death occurred between 10/1/2022 and 9/30/2023. Data was derived from Medicare claims processed as of 9/30/2023.

As patients are encouraged to plan ahead for end of life, discussing with family and completing Advance Care Plans, a metric is available that shows where the patient spent his/her last 6 months of life. This report shows the detail of how many days the patient spent as a hospital inpatient, in the Emergency Department, in a Skilled Nursing Facility, under Observation, and/or in Hospice. These days are subtracted from 6 months, showing the remaining days as being spent at home. You, the provider, know whether this last six months was spent as the patient desired.

At the top of the report, we have also provided averages and maximums for each category of type of days; these are based on all ACO REACH patients included in this report period.

As a reminder, NorthStar Palliative Care is available to provide palliative care services to eligible patients in need in the Traverse City Service Area. The goal of palliative care is to help patients with limited life expectancy manage symptoms better, reducing the need to go to the Emergency Department during the end stage of life by providing supportive care. This care is provided in the patient's home; NorthStar Palliative Care providers will go to the patient's home. Provision of palliative care services has been shown to lead to better hospice utilization.
