

## Pediatric Respiratory Conditions Medication Chart:

Respiratory conditions	Treatments	Common side effects	Counseling points
Whooping cough	Azithromycin, erythromycin, clarithromycin	Diarrhea, nausea, abdominal pain, skin rash	Take until the medicine is finished, even if you feel better.
Pneumonia	Amoxicillin or Amoxicillin-clavulanate (Augmentin)	Diarrhea, nausea, vomiting	Take until the medicine is finished, even if you feel better
Flu	Tamiflu	Nausea, vomiting, headache	Tamiflu does not treat or prevent illness that is caused by infections other than the influenza virus. It does not prevent bacterial infections that may happen with the flu.
Supportive measures	Children's Ibuprofen Children's Tylenol	Nausea, vomiting, skin rash	<p><b>Children's Ibuprofen dosing:</b> 5 to 10 mg/kg/dose (maximum dose: 600 mg/dose) every 6 to 8 hours; maximum daily dose: 40 mg/kg/day or 2,400 mg/day, whichever is less</p> <p><b>Children's Tylenol dosing:</b> 10 to 15 mg/kg/dose every 4 to 6 hours as needed. maximum daily dose: 75 mg/kg/day or 4,000 mg/day, whichever is less</p>
